



COACHING CODE OF CONDUCT

The Land Park Soccer Club is requiring all coaches to sign an agreement that will help ensure a fun, safe and respectful soccer season. Your behavior, and that of the children on your team, is a reflection of our club. We ask that you read the following and if you are in agreement, we welcome you to our soccer family.

- Be informed and understand the playing rules.
- Appreciate a good play no matter who makes it, applauding positive performances by either team. Children learn by example. Applauding good play teaches them this important lesson.
- Show compassion for any injured player.
- Avoid heckling, jeering or distracting players.
- Show respect for your team's opponents. Without them there would be no game.
- Avoid using profane and obnoxious language and behavior.
- Respect the judgment of the referee.
- Avoid criticizing players for loss of a game.
- Respect the property of others and authority of those who administer the competition.
- Always encourage your players to play by the rules.
- Do not publicly question any official's decision, and never doubt his or her honesty.
- Emphasize enjoyment and fun. Praise effort as well as improvement.
- Relax and enjoy the game whether your team wins or not.
- Realize that if your behavior is red carded by a referee the game ends for everyone.
- Abide by and respect the decisions of the Land Park Soccer Executive Board.
- Referee Abuse and Repeated Dissent will not be tolerated.

I agree to follow the above and share them with my team. I understand failure to follow these rules may result in my removal from the soccer program.
